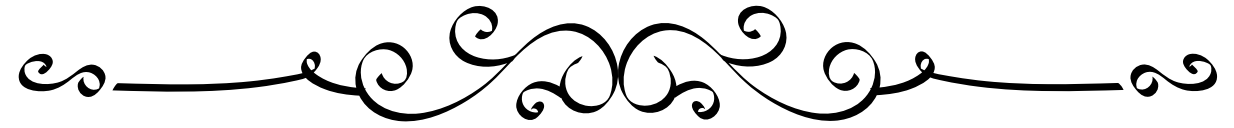


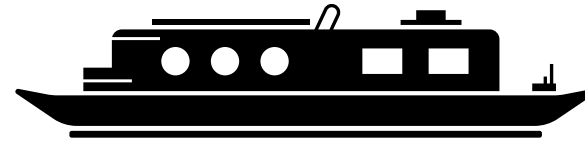

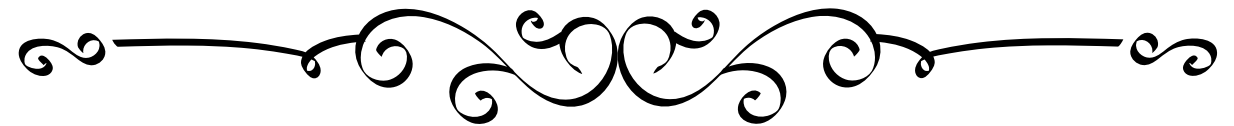

ONE LICENCE FOR ALL

Fighting licence fee discrimination

Canal and River Trust (CRT), who manage most of the inland waterways in England and Wales, are marginalising travelling boat dwellers by planning to charge a 'surcharge' to boaters for not having a home mooring. CRT is trying to eliminate our nomadic way of life. Let's come together to oppose the surcharge on our community.

Push CRT into accepting the results of their own consultation. 80% of those who completed the survey were boaters with home moorings and still 60% of all respondents chose options which did NOT include charging boats without home moorings more. The majority of licence holders do not agree with the policy being introduced by CRT.

No surcharges, one fair and equal licence for all.

12% of CRT income is raised in licence fees, 2.4% from boaters without home mooring. Funding raised by these measures is inconsequential to their bottom line, but could be life-changing for people who live on boats without home moorings driving them into hardship and poverty.
